1	Welcome Caroline welcomed all present, declared the meeting open.	СВ

5	Financial Update  The bank account is currently looking healthy which is wonderful as it is anticipated that a few large ticket items will be attended to in the coming weeks. These include new signage for use in Tokai Park as well as installation of backup power for the picnic site gate. Backup power has already been installed for the Drifter (Chrysalis) gate and is working very well through load shedding periods. 6	Track Maintenance		
	There is ongoing maintenance required throughout Tokai Park. This is complicated by water bars being filled with rocks and as these water bars are installed to prevent damage. This will be discussed with SANParks.		
	The track closest to the Flandorps in Lower Tokai Park has suffered significant damage this winter as the river that runs there burst its banks and the ground water appears to have risen resulting in water runoff from other areas of Lower Tokai Park flowing to this area are well. This will need to be assessed more thoroughly once the area is dry.	GC	
7	Planned Events		
	Members are encouraged to keep an eye on Facebook, WhatsApp and their emails for details of future events. The Tokai Big 5 Fynbos Ride has received some stunning photo entries and prizes will be shared soon.		
	A First Aid course specifically focussing on the types of injuries that are most likely to occur should one fall of a horse will be held. This will be open to all horse riders and the TDRA has been offered a discount for members attending the event. This is not a standard First Aid course but will have content that is intended to be of value for horse riders. We hope to see many of the Tokai horse riders at this event.		
	A full day workshop is also planned to assist our grooms with some introductory financial skills. A second workshop is available to focus on more complex matters however, that will be considered after this workshop has been run. No details related to income will be included in the discussion but rather the focus will be on saving, budgeting and debt at this stage.
